## COVID-19 SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Frequent hand washing and sanitation will be implemented.

We ask you not to bring children to playgroup if any family/household members have experienced any of the following symptoms ***within the previous 24 hours***:

- fever or chills
- cough
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- fatigue
- muscle or body aches
- headache
- new loss of taste or smell
- sore throat
- congestion or runny nose
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea

**Please stay home if anyone in the household has had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19 within the last 14 days.**

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of reported symptoms – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to SARS-CoV-2. Symptoms can include any of those listed above.

It is extremely important to stay home when sick until at least 24 hours after no longer having a fever (temperature of 100.4 or higher) or signs of a fever (chills, feeling very warm, flushed appearance, or sweating) without the use of fever-reducing medicine (e.g., Tylenol).

## INCLEMENT WEATHER

Your safety is important to us. Playgroups will be canceled if Clinton County RESA is **closed due to inclement weather**.
