How Does the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten Program Work:

Getting Started:

Print a 1000 Books Before Kindergarten reading log or download the free reading log app on your smartphone and start reading.

Track Your Reading:

Each time you read a book with your child, record it on your reading log or on the app.

Show Us Your Reading Log:

Each time you and your child reach a reading milestone (each 100 books). Take your reading log to a participating library (see below) and get your reward.

Why 1000 Books?

The Concept is simple, the rewards are priceless. Read a book to your newborn, infant, and/or toddler. The goal is to have read 1,000 books (yes you can repeat books) before your precious one starts Kindergarten.
